The SME owner must be a Pakistani national, conducting legal business in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. The business must have been registered before May 1, 2014 in case of an individual grant. However, in case of a Cluster Up gradation grant, only the group leader must have a business registered prior to May 1, 2014.
