Implementation Status Overview

The project became effective on Feb 6, 2013 upon signing of the legal documents and the first disbursement was released in July 2013. Staff hiring was completed in June 2013 through Technical Assistance provided under the project preparation facility. Staff training and orientation program was implemented in July 2013 and the PMU and 3 District Implementation Units (DIUs) are now fully operational. The Annual Work Plan for FY14 was approved by Project Steering Committee (PSC) and project introductory meetings with the Commissioner Bannu & DI Khan and District level Line Agencies have been held in August 2013. The PSC requested the PMU to be relocated to D.I.Khan in order to ensure proximity to local communities and administrative agencies. The Project Launch event was held in DI Khan district on October 8, 2013.

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To date, the project has:

- Identified 25 Union Councils for project interventions
- Identified 104 existing CBOs (including 21 women organizations) for social mobilization
- Capacity building trainings for office bearers of CBOs are in process
- A Baseline Survey in 25 selected Union Councils of three districts is in progress
- Relocation of PMU from Peshawar to DIKHAN was completed on September 25, 2013
- Project Website (www.sadp.gkp.pk) has been launched


